40/14	APOLOGIES Apologies were received from parish councillors Shane Boyd, Rupert Boyd and Andrew Smithson
41/14	MINUTES The minutes of the meeting on 10 July 2014 were accepted as a true record of the meeting.
42/14	MATTERS ARISING 08/14 The chairman provided an update on the progress of the discussions with Wiltshire County Council and the local Police. It would appear that both are happy with the speed limits in the parish despite recent accidents on both the A346 & A4. 43/14	DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST There were no declarations of interest. Pecuniary interests were considered for councillors and none were reported, it was agreed that the relevant records be updated accordingly.
44/14	PLANNING The impact of the proposed development at Salisbury Road was discussed and it was agreed that these discussions would form the response to the consultation being undertaken by the crown estates as part of the application process. (ACTION- CLERK).
45/14	FINANCE The clerk presented the year to date finance report. After a brief discussion it was duly noted. The meeting discussed the balance of funds held in respect of the forestry commission's amp production. It was agreed that the council should seek ways of eliminating this from its finances as it clouds the true financial picture of the parish. The chairman agreed that he would speak with the forestry commission about ways in
