6	<p>MARLBOROUGH AREA NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN (MANP)</p> <p>The Neighbourhood Plan is now going to a Referendum and leaflets and posters will need to be delivered around the Parish. GS, MP and NB have agreed to do a leaflet drop to properties in their areas.</p> <p>A copy of the leaflet would also be emailed to all parishioners for whom we had contact email addresses noting that the Councillors supported the Neighbourhood Plan. There have not been any plots of land identified within the parish for housebuilding, but part of the remit of the plan is to protect and potentially increase other amenities within the overall area covered by the Plan.</p> <p>In such small referendums in many cases those that object to the proposals can get a strong following, and because they feel strongly will vote, whereas those who have no objection sometimes will not make the effort to vote the PC should be encouraging parishioners to make their preference known by voting, be it for or against the Plan.</p>	
7	<p>FOREST LIAISON OFFICER REPORT</p> <p>NE had been in touch with Rob Cullen for an update on FE matters. He reported that 10,000 new trees have been planted, mainly in the Bedwyn area, to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. There were plans to thin some trees over the summer, in the area of Eight Walks.</p> <p>Rob said that he was moving up into a different post and that the post of <i>Beat Forester, Bristol and Savernake</i> is to be advertised and a new member of staff recruited. In the meantime someone else will be providing temporary cover from the end of July, but they are not familiar with Savernake.</p>

10	<p>CATG 5190</p> <p>MP reported that the CATG (Community Area Transport Group) has been renamed LHFIG (Local Highway & Footway Improvement Group) as its remit now also covers footpaths.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Clench Common - speed limit and traffic calming</u> GS & NB had a useful meeting with Martin Cook from Wiltshire Council's Highways department at Clench Common. <p>6 locations had been identified for white gates – 4 on the main road and 2 on the lane from Wootton Rivers. Due to the estimated costs of so many gates, it may be practical to start with the 2 gates on the lane as these may have the most effect, marking the change from fields to houses along this road. MC said that he would prefer the holes to be dug professionally for the signs on the main road.</p> <p>MP and NB would contact the company the previous gates came from and other potential suppliers to get quotes.</p> <p>Once the PC has some idea of the expected level of costs GS would endeavour to find out whether Ridgeway Sprayers and Ramsbury Estate are willing to contribute towards them - and establish what contribution they would be prepared to make.</p>	<p>MP & NB</p> <p>GS</p>
