17/14	<p><b>MATTERS ARISING</b></p> <p><b>05/14</b> The website supplier has been decided and the site is now in progress.</p> <p><b>06/14</b> Training available will be distributed when WALC sends the schedule for the coming year</p> <p><b>08/14</b> Wiltshire County Council has reviewed the speed limit on the A4 outside the Savernake Hospital site and are happy that it is appropriate. It is recommended that should the PC still be keen to pursue a reduction in the speed limit then they should do so through the area board. 18/14	<p><b>DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST</b></p> <p>There were no declarations of interest.</p> <p>Pecuniary interests were considered for councillors and none were reported, it was agreed that the relevant records be updated accordingly.</p>
19/14	<p><b>PLANNING</b></p> <p>The Chair revealed that the old depot site had been objected to by the Marlborough Town Council and that it was now therefore a matter for the county planning team.</p> <p>14/02863/FUL – the application for the construction of a sixth form centre at St Johns School was discussed and it was agreed that the council would offer no objections to</p>

	<p>the planned works.</p> <p>13/05455 – the application for the construction on a recreational building at Luton Lye House was discussed and it was agreed that the council would offer no objections to the planned works.</p> <p>It was agreed that new planning applications would not be loaded onto the website, however the url link to the Wiltshire Planning Portal would be included. <b>(Action – AS)</b></p>
<b>20/14</b>	<p><b>FINANCE</b></p> <p>PM presented the year end accounts and financial statements for 2013/14. After a brief discussion and due consideration the accounts and statements were approved as a true record of the councils finances.</p> <p>The council discussed the budget for 2014/15 and the planned spend. The council is assured that the necessary funds are in place to support the expenditure. The significant risks were assessed to the achievement of the council’s objectives and the council is assured of the adequacy of the arrangements to manage these.</p>
